



CDR CANS-PA Certification Instructions

The Child and Adolescent Needs and Strengths (CANS) is a decision-support tool to guide care planning, and to track changing strengths and needs over time.

Why Get Certified? Use of the CDR CANS-PA tool requires an active certification. The cost to become certified and have access to the CANS training website is \$12 and is the responsibility of the individual. Check with your agency to determine if the certification cost is reimbursable, or if a coupon code is available. For more information on coupon codes, contact support@communitydataroundtable.org.

Step-By-Step Instructions to Become Certified

1 OPEN BROWSER

Go to www.TCOMTraining.com.

2 SIGN UP

Click 'Sign Up.' Fill out the required fields. Click 'Sign Up Now.'



NOTE: Make sure to select your agency name that has " - CDR" after it.

3 SELECT BUNDLE

Once registered on the TCOM Training site, you will need to select the right course bundle. Bundles will appear based on your agency selection. Select the 'CDR, Pennsylvania' Bundle.

4 PURCHASE

Click 'Buy Now' to purchase your Bundle or enter a coupon code and click 'Redeem.' (See page 2 for instructions on how to unsubscribe from autopay.)

5 SELECT TEST

Once you have purchased your Bundle, click on 'My Training' located in the top menu bar. Select the course 'Community Data Roundtable CANS Mental Health 1.0'.

6 TAKE EXAM

After you have completed the course steps, click the 'Start Exam' box. You have two hours to complete the test. If you do not pass, you will be allowed to re-take the exam.

How to Recertify in the CDR CANS-PA

1 OPEN BROWSER

Go to www.TCOMTraining.com. Click the 'Login' button. If you forget your login information, please click the 'Forgot your Password?' link.

2 SELECT BUNDLES FROM MENU

In top menu, go to 'Trainings' and then 'Bundles.'

3 SELECT 'PENNSYLVANIA, CDR' BUNDLE

Select and Purchase the 'Pennsylvania, CDR' Bundle.

4 SELECT CDR-CANS

Find and click on 'Community Data Roundtable CANS Mental Health 1.0.'

5 CLICK 'CERTIFICATION EXAM'

If you choose not to watch the training videos or take the practice vignette, you can skip to the bottom of the page and click the 'Certification Exam' box.

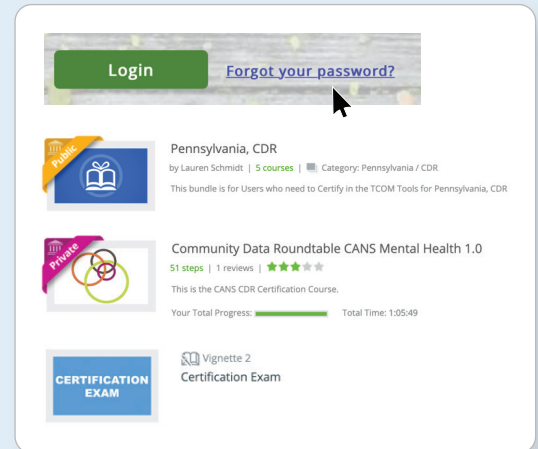
6 RETAKE EXAM

7 DOWNLOAD CERTIFICATE

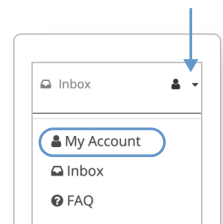
Download and save your new CANS Certificate! After you pass your exam, click on 'Me' and then 'My Certificates.' Click on the image of your Certificate to View and Download.



To update your CANS certification information in the DataPool, follow these steps:

1. Login to your DataPool account at pool.communitydataroundtable.org.
2. Click the grey person icon located at the top right side of the screen, and select 'My Account' from the menu options.
3. Scroll down to the CANS certification section and enter your new CANS certification date (month/day/year).

4. Upload your new CANS certificate.
5. Click on the 'Submit' button at the bottom of the screen. (Please note that we do verify this information).
